## Before programming:



**Professional development:** Springboard trains teachers to analyze assessment data, create individualized action plans, and communicate plans to families.

**Home visits:** Teachers visit the homes of their students to build parent buy-in and lay the foundation for a strong partnership.



## During programming:



**Coaching:** Site Leaders, hired from within the school, conduct a 5-week teacher coaching cycle while participating in leadership development sessions.

**Instruction:** Teachers use Springboard curricula to conduct daily, half-day literacy instruction with students grouped by reading level rather than age.



**Family workshops:** Every Wednesday during programming, teachers lead workshops to equip families with strategies and resources.

**Student Action Plans:** Teachers provide families with personalized action plans. These action plans give parents specific reading tips to coach their scholar at home, reinforcing the same ideas at school and at home.



## After programming:



**Learning bonuses:** Springboard distributes educational incentives—including books, backpacks, and tablets—during a capstone celebration.

## What outcomes can you expect?

Last summer, 5,200+ scholars replaced what is typically a 3-month reading loss with a 3.2-month reading gain, doubling their annual reading progress. Parent workshops consistently average 90%+ attendance. The Springboard experience helps teachers and families build habits that persist over the long term, as demonstrated by follow-up studies.
